



Access Information

- Market Place** From the Market place it is possible to access the Cathedral (through Penniless Porch), the Bishops Palace (through the Bishops Eye) and the Tourist Information Centre.
- Wells Cathedral** The Cathedral itself has separate access for wheelchair users through a separate door in the West Front.
- The gift shop and Cloisters Restaurant are accessed from the outside and not through the Cathedral. **The Chapter House and Library are not accessible by wheelchair.**
- Wheelchairs available on loan, please enquire at the Information Desk inside the Cathedral.
- Bishops Palace** The majority of the gardens, including St Andrew's Wells are accessible by wheelchair, as are the ground floor rooms in the Palace, the Chapel of St Mark and the Holy Trinity, and the Henderson Tea Rooms.
- Stenna stair lift available to first Floor on request.
- Wells Museum** For a reduced rate there is limited access in the Museum.
- Wells Shopmobility** Operates from Princes Road Car Park. For more information telephone 01749 678444.
- Wells Tourist information Centre** located on the ground floor of the Town hall and easily accessible. RADAR Keys may be purchased.
- We also hold a small selection of "Easy Access Walks" for the area produced by Cheddar Valley Access Group.
- The Bishops Palace Moat** The access around the moat and into the Recreation Park with Bandstand and Bishops Barn are suitable for Wheelchairs.
- Toilets** Disabled facilities are available in Union Street and Princes Road Car parks, Wells Recreation Ground and Town Hall Buildings (next to Town Hall).
- Wells Town Hall** Good access to the ground floor and a lift to the 1st floor, **the Mezzanine floor is not accessible.**
